- o **Falcon PSC** Tricia Mutobe reported that 20 families still don't have a shift in the classroom and 100 don't have support jobs. Laps for Learning earned \$28K vs \$17K last year.
- O Phoenix Student Council Report Mia Wercinski, 8th grade President, along with Zoe, 7th grade Vice President, reported that the council is pursuing kindness themes. One idea is a free food pantry for hungry kids. Supply could come from unopened hot lunches that kids didn't want to eat.
- o **Finance Report** Cheryl Leong not present. Libby Morris guided us through financials.
- Phoenix Campus Science Task Force The task force is involved with the two science fairs and next generation science standards. They have a website that is updated regularly www.dcsscience.com.

- Acting Superintendent Report/Phoenix Campus Director Report The County came out for the audit last week. Debby Perry reported it went well. Met with auditors and Miki Walker regarding Falcon Charter renewal. The first information night went well and drew about 150 people. First Phoenix campus tour drew about 80 people and there will be three more. Leadership is working on academic calendars for both schools. SSEP preliminary team chosen. Debbie Devine won an award for CalPads data! Annual fund Falcon \$139K 55% Phoenix \$140K 40%. Enrollment Phoenix 566 and Falcon 568. For next year there are already 140 applications for Phoenix, 114 applications for Falcon, and 19 for Home School. Deadline is February 1, 2018.
- Falcon Campus Director Report Miki Walker reported that there will be a meeting about the bathrooms in February as plans are still with DSA. TLC is having a monthly meeting with our SELPA to provide help to TLC. Monthly coffee with the Director has started. Spanish staff is starting a "restaurant" in each grade level to help teach Spanish.

Approved 6-0. Mr. Mettler Aye, Ms. McCreary Aye, Ms. Morris Aye, Mr. Shepherd Aye, Ms. Sanchez -- Aye, Ms. Eagle Aye.
- Succession Planning President Morris suggested adding a Special Education Director to oversee both campus TLCs to help Debby and Miki. Libby also discussed adding a BTSA/Curriculum person.
